STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES and SOURCES OF FINANCING *

The FY2024-25 Operations budget is higher as the TIF revenue continues to build. The 2021 URA has received a state grant of \$4 million to assist in building the pedestrian bridge as well as a \$3 million federal grant to assist in building Ice Age Drive in the TEA. Expenditures for these two projects account for the majority of the expenditures in these funds. The 2021 Sherwood URA is expected to generate revenue of \$17.8 million in FY2024-25. The FY2024-25 Capital Projects budget include the design and constructions of the Pedestrian Bridge over Highway 99W, the creation of Ice Age Drive to provide an east/west collector for the Tonquin Employment Area and clean up preperation for the Tannery site.
