

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Homeless and Housing Services Funding


Baseline: \$10.5 million

Strategic funding alignment

Housing Liaison in Health and Human Services:

- 5 new housing system experts embedded:
 - Maternal, Child and Family Program
 - Developmental Disabilities Division
 - Hawthorn Walk-in Center
 - Behavioral Health Division's Intensive Case Coordination Program
 - the Disability Aging and Veteran Services Program
- Leverage existing case manager capacity and relationships
- Reduce barriers to access housing resources

Strategic funding alignment

ARPA Funding for shelters:

- Just Compassion in Tigard future site for 30+ beds
- City of Beaverton new site under development for approx. 60 beds
- City of Hillsboro new site under development for approx. 70 beds
- SHS funds guarantee funding for program and building operations funding
- SHS Capital Improvement Fund TBD this Summer
