## **NOTARIZING PLATS**

## Notarizing plats (For Oregon Notaries: ORS 194.280):

(8) The imprint of the official **stamp of a notary public is not required** to effectuate a notarization of a subdivision or partition plat required under ORS 92.010 to 92.192 or a condominium plat required under ORS 100.115, or any replat, supplement or amendment thereto, if the following appear below the notary public's signature:

As a result of nondrying inks and the smudging of notary seals, we prefer that notaries do not stamp plats. Documents with stamps that are not clearly reproducible may be rejected. Additionally, documents that have or may smudge, smear, or bleed onto other documents may be rejected.

All signatures must be in archival black ink. Signatures with ball point pens, colored ink, etc. are not acceptable.

Crimped notaries are not acceptable.

Out of state notaries must comply with their local laws.
