### **MEETING SUMMARY**

1. Welcome/ Introductions	Committee members introduced themselves and commented on their perspectives regarding the CATT project. The over-arching theme is that there is great enthusiasm and a significant need for this type of facility in Washington County.
	<ul> <li>We need to be investing in addictions treatment and overdose prevention</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Substance abuse is a big concern for criminal justice system and hospital emergency departments – these are not the best interventions for SUD issues and alternatives are needed</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>How to get treatment and resources to people, earlier rather than later, on demand and immediate to capture the moment of change</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>There are opportunities for interdiction when police officers are contacting people in the community</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>This is a ground up effort and a huge opportunity to think differently</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Plan with an equity lens, lead with race (people of color have a different perspective and we need to be responsive)</li> <li>It's time to dismantle the barriers to treatment</li> </ul>

As we work together, let's remember that substance use touches many of us, either directly or through a loved one or friend. Sharing and embracing that perspective is essential to the success of our work.





<ol> <li>Project Update – PowerPoint presentation by Kristin and Walt</li> </ol>	<ul> <li>A PowerPoint presentation by Kristin covered the work completed to date, project structure, and key deliverables. This was a broad overview with some data provided that has helped inform the project. Additional data is available by request.</li> <li>Group Discussion: <ul> <li>The length of time it currently takes to get someone into treatment</li> <li>While it will be important to integrate with the criminal justice system, CATT should provide help that allows individuals to get help before – or as an alternative to – involvement in the legal system.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
3. Discussion: Project Scope	<ul> <li>Overview was provided on the phases of the project and other similar models. A key question was asked: How big do we go? Do we focus on a smaller model that is likely achievable or a very comprehensive model that integrates many other services?</li> <li>Group Discussion:</li> <li>Think big and carefully. Consider: <ul> <li>What Vancouver, WA, and San Antonio, TX, models went through before building. What were the political landscapes in those areas?</li> <li>Local political and community climate</li> <li>Social determinates of health</li> <li>Funding/reimbursement</li> <li>Measure 110 impact</li> <li>Entry point issues (before a crime is committed is better)</li> <li>Rules and payment systems result in a fractured system</li> <li>Important to use a strengths-based approach and build on existing resources</li> <li>If we don't think big, the program may not accomplish what we are hoping to do</li> <li>Start with partnerships. Understand how those developed in other similar projects.</li> <li>Add schools as a resource and partner</li> <li>Existing resources – look for the gaps in service availability</li> <li>Actively engage existing system partners</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
