COMMUNITY SERVICE ROAD WORK CREW Supplement to the Directives and Agreement Special Notice for General Wellness

- > You must stand a reasonable distance away from each other and respect personal space during morning check-in.
- Don't join the Road Work Crew if you feel sick and have symptoms that are flu-like, cold-like or are like seasonal allergies. You can contact the Department of Health and Human Services (503-846-4420) or your medical care provider if you are unsure of the cause of your symptoms.

- > We will provide these cleaning supplies:
 - Disinfecting Wipes
 - Hand Sanitizer
 - Portable Hand Washing Station
- We will provide the following Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):
 - Safety Vests
 - Eye protection
 - Ear protection
- > Face coverings aren't required. You can bring your own if you want to wear one.
- > You are expected to practice good hygiene and do your work safely throughout the day.
- > You must:
 - Sit in your seat without violating your co-worker's personal space.
 - Always wear your safety vest.
 - Wear your seatbelt whenever the van is in motion.
 - Wear ear and eye protection when told to do so.
 - Disinfect touch points in the van(s) before/after each trip.
 - Disinfect touch points of all tools before/after each use.
 - o Sanitize or wash hands before/after each trip and after using the restroom
- Some activities require the use of ear and eye protection. The Road Crew Supervisor will tell you when hearing or eye protection is needed. You will follow the direction of the Road Crew Supervisor related to all safety issues.
- If you willfully abuse PPE, wastes supplies, or refuses to use the appropriate PPE, you WILL BE SENT HOME AND WILL NO LONGER BE ALLOWED TO WORK ON ANY ROAD WORK CREW PROJECT. YOU WILL NOT BE CREDITED ANY HOURS WORKED ON THE DATE OF THE INCIDENT.
