Following a disaster, keep phone lines open for emergency responders.
Use 9-1-1 to report life- or property-threatening emergencies.

AFTER A POWER FAILURE

- Candles can be a safety hazard - use flashlights, lanterns, or light sticks.
- Turn off appliances and computers to avoid damage when power is restored.
- Check on neighbors.
- Charcoal BBQs emit carbon monoxide - do not use indoors or in enclosed areas.

AFTER AN EARTHQUAKE

- Prepare for aftershocks - beware of flying objects and avoid damaged buildings.
- Shut off your gas line **only** if it is damaged or leaking.
- Listen to radio or TV for emergency information.
- Check in with your out-of-state contact.
