Team Spotlight: Hector Munoz Arrow Roofing

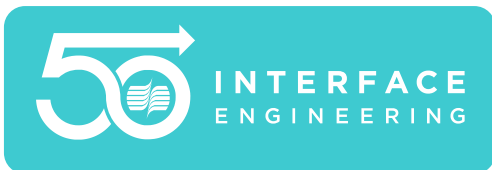
