

Internship Program

Washington County Health and Human Services

The internship program is designed to provide work opportunities and practical learning experiences for college and university students to enhance their academic preparation and expose them to various health and human services programs at the County level.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for an internship, a student must be enrolled in or a recent graduate of an approved educational institution. Students finishing High School or pursing an Associates, Bachelor's, Master's, or PhD degrees are welcome to apply. Internships may be part-time or full-time based on requirements of the project and the student's availability.

How to Apply:

1) Complete and submit electronically the application to hhs-interns@washingtoncountyor.gov with required attachments – 1) Resume and 2) Names and contact information for at least two references, preferably a professor and/or employer. Applicants may also submit a cover letter (optional).

2) Please note:

- a) Applications are collected throughout the year. As internship opportunities become available, applicants are notified of intern position vacancies.
- b) Washington County Health and Human Services (HHS) is able to support a **limited** number of internships; applicants are **strongly encouraged** to explore other internship placements, in addition to HHS.
