Staff presented one action item regarding Ridwell, Inc.'s request for an exemption from the requirement to obtain a certificate pursuant to WCC 8.04.130(C).

Recommended Action by Staff:

Based on the findings outlined in the staff report, Staff recommended that the Committee favorably recommend to the Board of Commissioners that the practice of collecting certain materials for recycling or reuse for a fee may be granted an exemption from the requirement to obtain a certificate.
