




And, Annual Wages for Low-Income Industries Grew Slightly Faster than Total Nonfarm Employment Between 2015 and 2020









But, Fair Market Rents for 1-Bedrooms Increased 30%

Washington County Experienced a Higher Occupancy Rate Than the City of Portland in 2020





Share of Jobs Created by Industry Type, Projections 2019-2029







Washington County's Unemployment Rate Dropped to Below 4.0% for the First Time Since Early 2020




Several Low-Income Industries Continue to See High Continued Unemployment Insurance Claims




Washington County, October 2021




Employment in Washington County Saw Growing Employment Levels in October 2021








Washington County has Recovered 80% of Jobs Lost in Spring 2020









Consumer Spending Remains Strong as We Enter the Holiday Season

Percent Change in All Consumer Spending*


In Washington, as of November 14 2021, total spending by all consumers increased by 27% compared to January 2020.
