Challenges
Access to treatment for unsheltered and sheltered individuals
is through Coordinated Entry. This reduces access to shelter and increases wait for shelter beds.
Continues to create challenges and delay the full utilization of contracted quality services in all program areas.

Opportunities
Workshop was held. Opening date is in December 2024.
Options for shelter long stayers once they are enrolled in a housing program
do not yet have a housing program enrollment, thereby allowing them to make their own housing plans.
Develop a model for a case conferencing table focused specifically on behavioral health.
Recommendations (and any additional assistance...)
Having a rapid response team or direct contact within ODHS would help our participants in our homeless services system.
Partnerships. This would allow engagement services from Behavioral Health system
to be accessed independently, even with enriched supportive services. Our system lacks the number of health system 'beds'.
