CURRENT SITUATION

- Negotiations to persuade the owner to extend affordability rates are at a standstill as we are not legally allowed to fulfill their demand for a non-disclosure agreement
- Nonprofit partner BRIDGE housing is working with the owner on their own offer but the process is moving much slower than anticipated
- Washington County is partnering with Oregon Housing & Community Services on a new program to quickly provide financial assistance to support households
- All residents at risk of losing affordability protections will qualify for the program

TIMELINE

Nov. to Dec. 2022

On-boarding new hire, Application available to tenants Jan. to Feb. 2023

Disbursing program payments

March to May 2023

Offering financial planning & relocation help

December 2023

Affordability rates end Dec 31 for all units



- One-time lump sum payment will be given to qualifying tenants to flexibly use for financial planning or relocation costs like security deposits and utility payments
- Housing Counselor will partner with you on:
 - 1) Long-term financial planning to budget the assistance payment
 - 2) Exploring affordable housing and communicating with landlords
