The goal is to create more workforce inflow for the housing services system in Washington County while building a more representative workforce

### **Training Services**

- Three-week training program
  - Basic employment skills
  - Housing & homeless services
  - Peer support core competencies
  - Ongoing training support




#### Intern Placement Services

- Placements with agencies providing homeless services in Washington County.
- Provide support for placement agencies
- Coordinate with service providers
- Administer pay



#### Supported Employment Services

- Recruit and screen applicants
- Provide employment coaching to interns
- Assist interns in securing permanent employment





### Timeline and Logistics

- One-year demonstration
- Training launches January 9<sup>th</sup>
- Two cohorts of fifteen interns
  - Winter 2023
  - Spring 2023
- Referrals are still being accepted
