
Digital Literacy Workshops

COMMUNITY LEGAL & EDUCATIONAL ACCESS & REFERRAL CLINIC

The CLEAR Clinic is a legal clinic, providing free services to Oregonians. The clinic is housed at Cascade campus, but will also offer pop-up dates at Willow Creek Center.

- Criminal record and eviction expungements;
- Eviction legal defense for Portland residents;
- DACA renewals and immigration legal screenings;
- Limited scope deportation defense;
- Legal name and gender-marker changes; and
- Other advice and referrals for legal services, PCC resources, and community-based resources.

GET HELP Basic Needs Support

House Bill 2835 requires Oregon public colleges and universities to employ Benefits Navigators to help students connect with basic needs and benefit programs.

Areas of basic needs can include: ●childcare ●food ●housing

•financial stability •legal services •transportation •social connection

 access to technology •mental and physical health •access to hygiene services and supplies.
