Provides job placement, and academic support for <u>Clackamas County</u> youth aged 14-24. Assists with finding short-term training programs, internships, or job placement support as per the youth's field of interest.

▶ OYEP

Occupational skills training and paid work experiences for Youth in Multnomah, Washington and Clackamas Counties aged 14-24.

▶ SummerWorks

Youth that apply for SummerWorks get placed at temporary paid internships with transportation assistance and job-related supports.

Youth can work up to 160 hours.

► WEXY

A year-round paid work experience program similar to SummerWorks where youth are placed in paid internships and receive career coaching support.

Youth can work up to 150 hours.
