

What is it?

- Collaborative effort to build a by-name list of all people experiencing unsheltered homelessness within target areas
- Intensive street outreach & case conferencing for people experiencing unsheltered houselessness
- Collaborative problem-solving to address barriers keeping people from shelter and sustainable housing

LC3 Strengths & Successes

- By-Name List as an outreach tool
- Collaboration with other teams and the county
- Resources/funds to address barriers experienced by people living outside

Ongoing Barriers Experienced by People Living Unsheltered

- Staying in contact with outreach (due to moving often and lack of phone)
- Serious medical vulnerabilities, exacerbated by being outside
- The role of mental health & trauma in shelter readiness.
- Wait-times for shelter & housing

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Important Takeaways From LC3

- It takes time
- People who are unsheltered in our community face complicated barriers to accessing shelter & housing
- Multiple attempts at accessing shelter may be needed
- Hesitation & resistance are a part of the process
- Outreach teams are a critical resource in addressing unsheltered homelessness, but not an enforcement tool
- Some needs cannot be met within SHS

Final Thoughts: Continuing (and growing) the LC3 work & Areas to Enhance

- Recurring LC3 meetings will continue
- Continue By-Name List and collaboration to address barriers

Opportunities for deeper work & improvements

- More movement within the shelter system
- Deeper integration of housing programs
- Deeper collaboration with healthcare
