Subject: Proposed Ordinance No. 627 – An Ordinance Amending the Transportation Plan to

Replace the 170th /173rd Study Area between Walker and Baseline Roads with a

General Roadway Alignment for 170th/173rd

Enclosed for your information is a copy of proposed Ordinance No. 627. A summary of the ordinance, scheduled hearing dates, and other relevant information is provided below. If you have any questions about the ordinance, or if you would like additional information, please contact the Planning Division.

Ordinance Summary

Ordinance 627 makes specific changes to maps and text in the Washington County 2020 Transportation Plan that was adopted in October 2002. The effect of these changes is to replace the 170th/173rd Study Area currently in the Plan with the general location of the 170th/173rd Avenue Arterial between Baseline and Walker Roads. The general location of this roadway will be consistent with the alignment recommended during the project development process.

More specifically, Ordinance 627 modifies the 2020 Washington County Transportation Plan Functional Classification System map, Lane Numbers map, Study Areas map and plan text describing the 170th/173rd Study Area.

<u>Transportation Plan changes proposed in Ordinance 627 are as follows:</u>

- On the **Functional Classification System map**, the general location of a proposed Arterial roadway connecting 170th and 173rd Avenues between Walker and Baseline Roads would be identified. The functional classification of 170th/173rd would not be changed.
- On the **Lane Numbers map**, the proposed new Arterial roadway section would be identified as having "2-3 Lanes." The "2-3 Lanes" designation is consistent with other portions of the roadway.
- On the Study Areas map, the 170th/173rd Study Area would be eliminated.
- In text describing Study Areas identified in the plan, the reference to and description of the 170th/173rd Study Area would be eliminated.

Hearings will be held in the Shirley Huffman Auditorium in the Public Services Building, 155 N. 1st Avenue, Hillsboro, Oregon.

On September 21, 2004, the Board may choose to adopt the ordinance, make changes to it, continue the hearing to a future date, or reject the ordinance. If it is adopted, it would become effective on October 21, 2004.

How to Submit Comments

Submit oral or written testimony to the Board and/or the Planning Commission at one of the public hearings. Written testimony may be mailed or faxed to the Board or Planning Commission in advance of the public hearings in care of the Planning Division. At this time, we are unable to accept e-mail as public testimony.

6	The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Oregon, ordains:			
7	SECTION 1			
8	A. The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Oregon, recognizes that			
9	the Transportation Plan Element of the Comprehensive Plan (Volume XV) was adopted on October			
10	25, 1988, by way of Ordinance Nos. 332 and 333, with portions subsequently amended by Ordinance			
11	Nos. 343, 382, 409, 419, 426, 432, 450, 463, 470, 471, 473, 474, 480, 483-485, 493, 494, 503, 515,			
12	526, 537, 542, 546, 552, 556, 588, 601, 609, and 611.			
13	B. Subsequent ongoing planning efforts of the County have concluded that modifications			
14	to the Transportation Plan are warranted. The Board takes note that such changes are necessary for th			
15	benefit of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Washington County, Oregon.			
16	C. Under the provisions of Washington County Charter Chapter X, the Land Use			
17	Ordinance Advisory Commission has carried out its responsibilities, including preparation of notices,			
18	and the County Planning Commission has conducted one or more public hearings on the proposed			
19	amendments and has submitted its recommendations to the Board. The Board finds that this			
20	Ordinance is based on that recommendation and any modifications made by the Board, as a result of			
21	the public hearings process.

	D. The Board finds and takes public notice that it is in receipt of all matters and					
	information necessary to consider this Ordinance in an adequate manner, and that this Ordinance					
	complies with the Statewide Planning Goals, the Metro Urban Growth Management Functional Plan,					
	the Regional Transportation Plan, and the standards for legislative plan adoption, as set forth in					
	Chapters 197 and 215 of the Oregon Revised Statutes, the Washington County Charter, and the					
	Washington County Community Development Code.					
SECTION 2						
	The following exhibits, attached and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby adopted as					
	amendments to the Transportation Plan:					
	(A) Exhibit 1 (1 page) amending the Functional Classification Systems Map of the					
	Transportation Plan;					
	(B) Exhibit 2 (1 page) amending Proposed Lane Numbers Map of the Transportation Plan;					
(C) Exhibit 3 (1 page) amending the Washington County Study Area Maps of the						
	Transportation Plan; and					
	(D) Exhibit 4 (1 page) eliminating the description of the 170 th /173 rd Study Area in the Study					
	Area section of the Transportation Plan.					
SECTION 3						
	All other Comprehensive Plan provisions that have been adopted by prior ordinance, which are					
	not expressly amended or repealed herein, shall remain in full force and effect.					
	SECTION 4					
	All applications received prior to the effective date shall be processed in accordance with ORS					
	215.427 (2003 Edition).





1. Eliminate the description of the 170th/173rd Study Area in the Study Area section of the Transportation Plan (A-Engrossed Ordinance No. 588, Exhibit 12, page 8) as follows:

170th/173rd Study Area:

The need for a north-south arterial roadway has been established in this Study Area. The Board has determined that the alignment for this arterial connection should be determined during the project development process that is scheduled to begin in January 2003, and that the two alignment alternatives identified during the Plan Update process (i.e., Alignment Alternatives 1 and 2) should be among those considered during that process.
