Ordinance Purpose and Summary

Ordinance No. 630 proposes to amend the Rural/Natural Resource Plan Element of the *Washington County Comprehensive* Plan to change the boundary (Mineral and Aggregate Overlay District A) of Hayden Quarry, located south of Forest Grove. The amendment proposes to shift future excavation from the south part of the quarry to the north. The proposed quarry boundary change will also change the impact boundary (Mineral and Aggregate Overlay District B), which includes all areas within 1,000 feet from the quarry boundary.

Who Is Affected

Property owners of tax lots located within the existing and proposed boundary of Hayden Quarry and its existing and proposed impact boundary.

What Land is Affected

Tax lots located within the existing and proposed boundary of Hayden Quarry and its existing and proposed impact boundary.

Key Provisions

- Remove the Overlay District A from 17.4 acres of Hayden Quarry (portion of Tax Lot 200, Tax Map No. 1S3 20).
- ➤ Apply the Overlay District A to approximately 31.7 acres (Tax Lot 405 and a portion of Tax Lot 700, Tax Map No. 1S3 20) for the purpose of extracting aggregate resources and associated activities, including the quarry's access, scales and offices.
- ➤ Modify the Overlay District B to include all areas within 1,000 feet of amended District A.

Hearings will be held in the Shirley Huffman Auditorium in the Public Services Building, 155 N. 1st Avenue, Hillsboro, Oregon.

On October 5, 2004, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) may choose to adopt the ordinance, make changes to it, continue the hearing to a future date, or reject the ordinance. If it is adopted, it would become effective on November 4, 2004.



The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Oregon, recognizes that the "Rural/Natural Resource Plan Element (Rural)" (Volume III) was readopted with 8 amendments on September 9, 1986, by way of Ordinance No. 307, with portions subsequently 9 10 amended by Ordinance Nos. 342, 383, 411, 412, 458, 459, 462, 480, 482, 499, 539, 547, 572, 11 574, 578, 588, 598, 606, 609, and 615. Subsequent ongoing planning efforts of the County indicate a need for changes to 12 B. the Rural/Natural Resource Plan Element regarding Hayden Quarry, including the Mineral and 13 Aggregate Overlay District designation. The Board takes note that from time to time changes to the 14 planning documents are necessary for the benefit of the health, safety, and general welfare of the 15 residents of Washington County, Oregon. 16 17 C. Under the provisions of Washington County Charter Chapter X, the Land Use Ordinance Advisory Commission has carried out its responsibilities, including preparation of notices. 18 and the Planning Commission has conducted a public hearings process on the proposed amendments 19 20 and has submitted its recommendations to the Board. The Board finds that this Ordinance considered 21 those recommendations, and includes any modifications made by the Board, as a result of the public 22 hearings process.

The Significant Natural Resources Map of the Rural/Natural Resource Plan Element is amended to show changes to the District A boundary of the Mineral and Aggregate Overlay District for Hayden Quarry as shown on the map below. The subject site is located on Tax Map 1S3 20, Tax Lots 200, 405 and 700. 17.4 acres are removed from District A at the southern boundary of the site. 19.7 acres are added to District A at the northern boundary of the site.



The Significant Natural Resources Map of the Rural/Natural Resource Plan Element is amended to show changes to the District B boundary of the Mineral and Aggregate Overlay District for Hayden Quarry as shown on the map below. The affected properties are located on Tax Maps 1S3 20 and 1S3 29.
