 APPLICATION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS: Completed "Block Party Authorization Application" form. Completed "Block Party Street Closure Petition" (signed by a representative of each residence fronting the street to be closed). Map showing (1) street requested to be closed, (2) surrounding vicinity, (3) how access to nearby streets will be maintained, (4) the houses (with addresses) fronting the street to be closed. The map can be hand-drawn, but to expedite the processing of your application please make the map legible and use 8-1/2" x 11" paper. Application fee: None.
 DTHER REQUIREMENTS Limit hours of operation to daylight hours. Emergency vehicle access must be maintained at all times. To close off the street, ensure the safety of block party participants by using materials that adequately mark the closed-to-vehicles area. Options include, but are not limited to, traffic cones, sawhorses, and reflective tape. Vehicles may not be used to close off the street. Comply with all county and city ordinances. The day of your block party, notify Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue of the block party are events@tvfr.com or 503-649-8577. Area must be cleaned-up after the block party is over.
