Frances Street to Tualatin Valley Highway

PROJECT INFORMATION

Open House #1 - June 21, 2018

Project Location:

Cornelius Pass Road, between Frances Street and TV Highway (OR 8)

Project Purpose:

Improve safety and capacity of the last remaining three lane segment of Cornelius Pass Road between TV Highway and US 26.

Project Elements:

- Widen Cornelius Pass Road from three lanes to five lanes (two travel lanes in each direction and a center turn lane)
- Dedicated right-turn lane from westbound TV Highway to northbound Cornelius Pass Road
- Continuous bike lanes and sidewalks
- Street lighting
- Storm drainage upgrades
- Willamette Water Supply Program (WWSP) 48-inch water pipeline (see WWSP's display for more information)

Funding:

The roadway improvement project budget is \$17.1 million, including engineering, right-of-way and construction, and is funded through the MSTIP Bonding Cost-sharing Program (see funding display for more information). The Willamette Water Supply Program will fund the costs associated with the 48-inch water pipeline.
