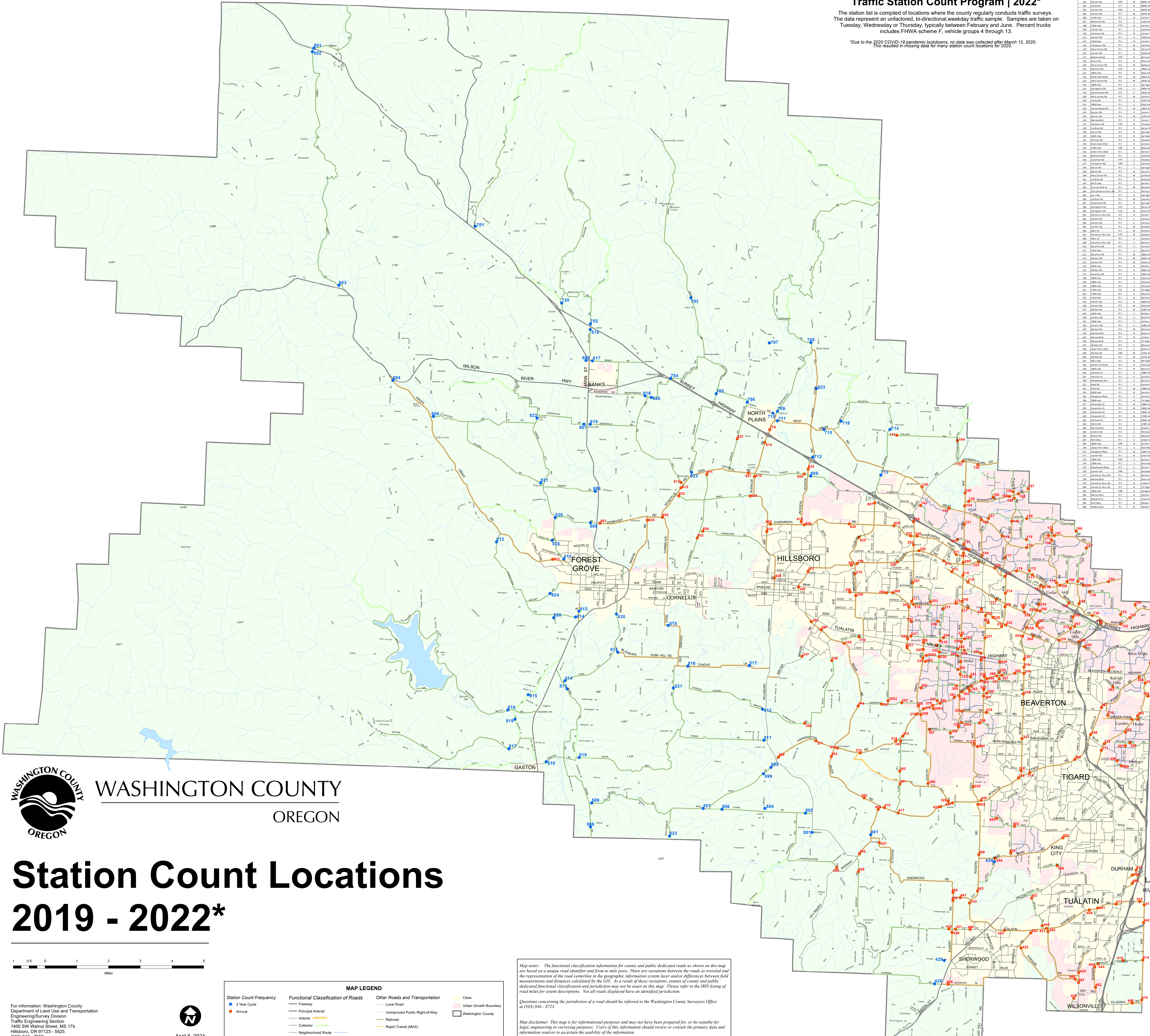


Traffic Station Count Program | 2022*

The station list is compiled of locations where the county regularly conducts traffic surveys. The data represent an unfactored, bi-directional, weekday traffic sample. Samples are taken on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday, typically between February and June. Percent trucks includes FHWA scheme F, vehicle groups 4 through 13.

*Due to the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic lockdowns, no data was collected after March 12, 2020. This resulted in missing data for many station count locations for 2020.
