



Tualatin-Sherwood Road

Borchers Drive to Langer Farms Parkway

Project scope:

- Tualatin-Sherwood Road, between Borchers Drive and Langer Farms Parkway, will be widened to five lanes - two travel lanes in each direction with a center turn lane.
- Buffered bike lanes will be installed on each side of the road.
- Drainage, traffic signals and street lighting will be upgraded.
- The Willamette Water Supply Program will install a 66-inch drinking water pipeline in conjunction with the roadway improvements.

Schedule:

- Final design will be completed in summer 2020.
- Construction is expected to start in fall 2020.
- Construction is expected to take up to three years to complete.
- Project schedules are subject to change.

Construction staging:

- Construction will be staged to widening one half of the road at a time beginning with the south half of Roy Rogers Road and the north half of Tualatin-Sherwood Road.
- The existing number of travel lanes will be maintained during daytime/peak hours; lane reductions during only nighttime/non-peak hours.
