

Tualatin-Sherwood Road

Chicken Creek to Borchers Drive

Project scope:

- Roy Rogers Road, between the Chicken Creek Bridge and Borchers Drive, will be widened to five lanes - two travel lanes in each direction with a center turn lane.
- Raised cycle track will be installed on each side of the road.
- Drainage and street lighting will be upgraded.
- The Willamette Water Supply Program will install a 66-inch drinking water pipeline in conjunction with the roadway improvements.

Schedule:

- Final design will be completed in winter 2021.
- Construction is expected to start in spring 2021.
- Construction is expected to take two years to complete.
- Project schedules are subject to change.

Construction staging:

- Construction staging will be determined as the design progresses.
- The existing number of travel lanes will be maintained during peak hours; lane reductions during only non-peak hours.
