Project Overview

Saltzman Road: Laidlaw Road to Bayonne Lane:

- Narrow vehicle lanes; no bicycle and pedestrian facilities
- MSTIP 3e description (\$5.3M allocation): Full improvement of existing alignment, including wider travel lanes, bike lanes and sidewalks; OR partial funding for improvement on "western alignment." Total project estimate [to improve existing alignment] is \$6.5 million. The remaining \$1.2 million is proposed from the Bonny Slope West funding plan.
- Improvement options to be evaluated by the BCC

* Revised option (2-3 lanes, curb-tight sidewalks; tighter curve at Paul property) shown on slide 7


Western Alignment (2-3 lanes)



Initial Eastern Alignment Plan (3 lanes)




→ Initial Eastern Alignment Profile (3 lanes)




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Revised Eastern Alignment Plan (new info)








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Western Alignment Plan (2-3 lanes)

→ PAC Comparison Criteria

Comparison Criteria ¹	Eastern Alignment	Eastern Interim Alignment	Western Alignment	Reason for Higher Impact Potential
Environmental Permitting	**	**	***	Would need to demonstrate to DSL/ACOE/CWS that it is the least environmentally damaging or impactful alternative.
Stormwater Management	****	***	****	Western and Eastern Alignment have more impervious area then Eastern Interim Alignment.
Structures	**	**	****	Bridge construction vs. culvert replacement
Traffic	*	*	***	Additional improvements may be necessary for neighborhood connectivity at 130 th /Laidlaw.
Utilities	**	**	****	Utilities within private easements may be impacted by construction and may have reimbursable relocations at the cost of the Project.
Right-of-Way	***	**	****	The Western Alignment will have a larger ROW needs due to new alignment.
Trees	***	***	**	Larger clearing of wooded area.
Traffic Control	***	****	**	Eastern Alignment requires road closure and detour route during construction.
Safety	*	***	*	Horizontal curve has lower safe speed.
Estimated Total Project Cost	\$10.6 m	\$8.2 m	\$19.1 m	Includes 40% construction continency and 15% administration contingency (all alignments)
