



Transportation Projects Bid Process

Most of Washington County's road/street improvement projects are built by construction contractors selected through a competitive bid process. Oregon law requires us to select contracts over \$250,000 through this process.

1

We prepare a **bid solicitation package** describing the scope of work, contractor responsibilities and our expectations.

We **advertise the bid solicitation** on the OpenGov Procurement website for two to four weeks.



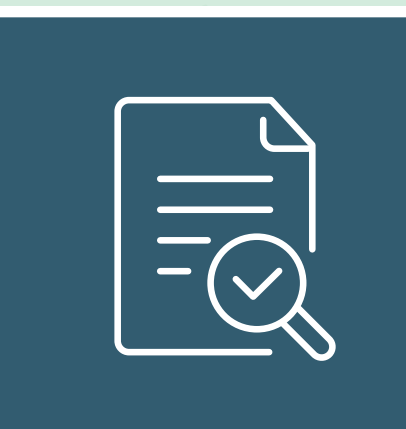

On the **bid opening date**, all the bids received on time are opened, read aloud and recorded on OpenGov. Bid openings are currently online only.

We review the **lowest bid** to make sure it meets all requirements.

After a seven-day notice period, we ask the Washington County Board of Commissioners to **award the contract**.

Both the County and the contractor **sign the contract**.
