

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

Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund

- Established in HB 2017 with employee payroll tax
- Funds public transportation statewide to:
 - Improve service to low-income populations and students
 - Reduce service fragmentation
- Available funding:
- Formula funds generated outside TriMet, SMART districts Competitive discretionary and intercommunity grants Includes Special Transportation Fund (STF) for older adults and
- persons with disabilities per HB 1601
 - STF retains separate application process



County Transit Committee

- Charge: Recommend transit priorities for STIF to Board:
- Service for areas outside TriMet, SMART districts
- Connect areas to TriMet district
- First/last mile connections within district

County Transit Committee

Committee operations

- Committee chair to call meetings as needed to advise on transit project priorities
- Consensus approach desired; vote of majority present if consensus cannot be reached
- Quorum is simple majority of members/alternates \bullet
- All meetings are public with advance notice \bullet
- Meeting summaries created, distributed \bullet
- Chair may form subcommittees, as needed \bullet


STIF Process

- Board approves plan and projects for TriMet's tri-county Public Transportation Improvement Plan (PTIP)





- FY 2021-23: Expanded service structure to add flexibility






Rural work force shuttle



- FY 2021-23: Added Saturday service and Cornelius extension


GroveLink

• Weekday community circulator service (6:30 a.m.-7 p.m.)



North Hillsboro Link

- Deviated fixed-route service
- Weekday and weekend service (5 a.m.-9:45 p.m.)
- 30-minute service on weekdays; reduced service on weekend



Tualatin Shuttle

- Commuter service (5 a.m. -9am, 3 p.m.-7 p.m.)
- Plan to add two additional hours each weekday
- Grant funded extension on Borland Road (green line)
- Proposed modification (red line) to expand service area

Stop Enhancements

- Grant funded
- Stop improvements at up to 22 locations (over 40% of shuttle network)
- Signage, landing pad, benches, shelters, etc.
- Coordinate with cities to implement
- Design, procurement and installation

→ Technology upgrade

- Grant funded
- Software and equipment upgrades
- Improve on time performance and operational efficiency with real-time data for route optimization and schedule adjustments





COVID Impacts to Annual Ridership


