• Project Location:

Intersection of Walker Road and Murray Boulevard

• Roadway Information:

- o Walker Road:
 - Street Classification: Arterial
 - Posted Speed: 35* and 45 mph (speed limit will not change)
 - Design Speed: 35* and 45 mph
 - Daily Traffic Volumes: 25,000 vehicles/day
- o Murray Boulevard:
 - Street Classification: Arterial
 - Posted Speed: 45 mph (speed limit will not change)
 - Design Speed: 45 mph
 - Daily Traffic Volumes: 27,000 vehicles/day

Project Goals:

- Consistent roadway cross-section throughout corridor
- o Improve bridges (2) and culverts (2)
- Improve safety for all travel modes
- Design with the future development of the area in mind
- **Project Funding/Budget:** Funded through a combinations of phase 3d of the County's Major Streets Transportation Improvement Program (MSTIP) and Traffic Development Taxes (TDT). Project budget is \$14.1 million for engineering design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction.

• Project Schedule:

- Final roadway design: thru Spring 2017
- o Right-of-Way acquisition: thru Fall 2017
- o Construction: Spring 2018 thru Fall 2019
