

Joint CPO 6 & CPO 7 Meeting Minutes

Date: Monday, March 10, 2025

Location: In person meeting was at the PCC Willow Creek Campus. The meeting was both in person and virtual on Zoom, although sound quality issues impacted the presentation and Q&A follow up.

Meeting was called to order by Nancy Hazelett, CPO 7 Chair at 7:00 PM.

Community Briefings:

Representatives from the Washington County Sheriff's Office (WCSO), Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue (TVF&R), Tualatin Valley Water District (TVWD) and Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District (THPRD) provided updates about local events and issues.

Presentation Topic: MAX Crossing at SW 185th Avenue & W Baseline Road

Presenters: John Fasana (Washington County LUT), Coral Egnaw & AJ O'Conner (TriMet), Gregg Snyder (City of Hillsboro), Kara Hall, **PE** (City of Beaverton).

Presenters discussed the current system for regulating traffic at this intersection where MAX trains intersect with autos, bikes and pedestrians, and described options for improving this. A grade separation for the light rail was identified as a better option; costs and funding issues involved in different options were shared. Presenters described ways citizens could advocate for one or several of the different options to improve this area.

Nancy Fletcher from CPO6 was introduced as the new Chair for the CCI Middle Housing Committee. CPO members were encouraged to contact her with questions and updates on this type of housing.
