Welcome, Introductions

- Climate Friendly and Equitable Communities Parking Update Steve Kelley
 - Slide deck: Governor Executive order 20-04 (March 2020) Climate Friendly Equitable C
 - Please refer to the slide deck for notes
 - Q: Mary; do the new parking rules apply to areas outside the UGB? A: They do not, they only apply with in the urban growth boundary.
 - Q: Bruce, is there allowance for residence to have handicap parking? A: I am not an expert; it depends on the size of the lot and parking spaces provided.
 - Q Bruce: Removing parking mandates, is it up to the developer to specify the amount of handicap parking available? Yes, Q: For businesses, is it up to the business to determine the number of parking spaces available for handicap? Yes.
 - Q Gretchen: What adjustment is there for people with disabilities, who cannot walk a half mile to a bus and/or need a car parking spot? A:
 - o Q Paul: Is there a requirement on dimensions of a parking space
 - o Gretchen, off street parking is challenging due to space for street parking.
- Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District Visioning Task Force: Holly Thompson
 - Slide Deck:
 - How do you engage community when the topics are not warm and fuzzy? A: Change the model, some of the spaces are uninviting for folks when they walk in and the people in

the space do not look like them. The current structures don't work for all people. The model needs to change to adapt to the need of community. Talking to the community who are not participating asking what they need from you to participate.

- The issue is not of interest, but lack of ability to participate in the current structures that are outdated.
- Virginia how does park and rec recognize the historical context of the land in which the park is located? Is there interpretive signage?
- Bruce: it's painful to acknowledge the budget impacts of the current budget situations.
 Are you offering incentives for volunteers? Yes, we are offering to pay for certifications for volunteers. The aquatic center has a robust pool of lifeguards.

WCCCI Subcommittees

• Significant Natural Resources Subcommittee Report

- Jim: SNR met 3x over the past month. A motion was made to ask CCI to send a letter to BCC and LCDC regarding the support of the hearing officer. The hearing officer has a wealth of historical information. Mary moves that Jim draft a letter with CCI support for the hearing officer support, and the letter be approved by CCI steering committee members. Gretchen second the motion. Motion carries, 11 yes, 0 no
- There are certain requirements that LCDC has, such as 20 copies of exhibits. Jim will research the hearing requirements prior to printing.
- Paul, after reading what Jim sent out, he found it difficult to follow all the arguments, but understand the objective, however the jurisdictional boundaries are not clear state vs local.

Legislative Report: Gretchen

- House 3001 passed out from the Ways and Means and was sent to the senate. It will have a do pass recommendation. It provides \$300 Million dollars going to various sources, homeless, rent protection, housing in rural counites, homeless youth. IT will require a needs analysis for urban cities under 10k. The bill is supposed to be on the governor's desk by the 30th.
- Concerns: it mandates easing up of planning procedures and timelines that allows community to be involved and provided input. There is a land use component that expires processes. The governor would like 36,000 housing units built a year. Its great for cities not to charge for senior and affordable housing, but it allows developers get out of paying development related charges, 10am-12pm April 8, 2023. Hearing Location TBD
- HB 2981 expedites financing for developers
- Work session on Monday, to set up a pilot program do to 100% financing for people with low income to get into stable housing
- SB 870 Ready to go to the house would require all new public buildings to be built with higher energy efficiency, but there is no funding attached.
- WC Board agreed to buy a 55+ older senior housing, after the owner of the building share their intention to triple the rent prices. This purchase saved 150 seniors from be left with unstable housing

- Mandate to state dept of energy to provide a rebate for homeowners who are purchasing energy efficient homes and appliances who are low income. The concern is the expediting planning and funding some of the things developers should be paying for.
- 3174 LOC and the county lead are putting together to help the state develop a pilot program to teach community how to write grants, education for planners, getting more staff will be helpful.
- Gretchen will continue to attend hearing and keep CCI updated on developments
