# Discussion: County's Strategic Update 2024-28

Kathryn Harrington, Chair of the Washington County Board of County Commissioners (BCC), and Pam Treece, Commissioner for District 2, will visit to inform the CCI of the process the BCC is using to develop the County's Strategic Update 2024-28, and what to expect for providing community input. The potential adoption timeline of the Plan is in the early months of 2024.

The original County 2000 Plan, approved in 1986, identified the County's fundamental approaches to its service delivery roles, principles, and priorities as a blueprint for the development and implementation of County policies, programs and operations. Only minor updates to the plan were made in the 1990s.
