David Moore and Lynne Foster presented about the City of Hillsboro Historic Landmarks Advisory Committee. They gave an overview of the group and what they do and who is on the committee. They focus on properties within the Hillsboro city limits. They have a Joan Kraemer grant available for people looking to restore historic homes and the grant amount has just increased to \$4,000 minimum to help keep up with rising costs. The group meets on a monthly basis and helps facilitate the approval of remodeling and saving of historic properties. They also have a historic property cultural resource inventory where people can check to see what properties are on the list. For more information about the group please visit:

The group also discussed the larger Washington County cultural resource inventory that was done in the 1980s as part of the statewide goal 5 process. While the county did the inventory there is no digital copy available nor is it cover their maps and online resources when looking at development. David Moor did some digging and did locate the hard copy of the resource inventory where he made copies of some of the pages for the historic Scholls and Kinton area. Several members of the group wanted and hope to see the larger document and questioned why there was not a larger committee for the county or why the county never did more with the document that still exists. Other members hope to get a digital copy produced for easier access.
