Detective Jeremy Chedester, of the Washington County Sheriff's Office Investigations Division, FBI/Joint Terrorism Task Forces will share with us the interrelationship and motivations of domestic extremist groups operating in the county, state and nation.

The Sheriff's Office will present how they assess candidates' psychological profiles to recruit broad-minded people and limit extremist individuals. They will share what actions are recommended for community members to either avoid or to address extremism in their communities, and we will learn about the training School Resource Officers receive to help students resist involvement.

Understanding these groups takes on more urgency in the face of the Oregon Secretary of State Audits Division's 2022 Advisory Report: Oregon Can Do More to Mitigate the Alarming Risk of Domestic Terrorism and Violent Extremist Attacks.
