Aloha High School Teacher Arrested for Sex Abuse

January 21, 2014 -- Earlier this month, concerned citizens came forward to report suspicions that an Aloha High School teacher, Eric Wise, 37, was involved in a sexual relationship with a former student, who was underage at the time. Washington County Sheriff's Detective investigated the allegations and arrested Mr. Wise.

Mr. Wise is a marketing and business teacher at Aloha High School and was the victim's teacher for several years. He has been employed by the Beaverton School District since 2006.

Detectives interviewed several people who they believed had knowledge of the case and developed probable cause that the crime of Sex Abuse II and Furnishing Alcohol to a Minor had been committed.

On January 21, 2014 at 11:00 a.m., Mr. Wise turned himself in to detectives at the Sheriff's Office. This case will be heard by a Washington County grand jury in the near future.

The Beaverton School District cooperated fully with this investigation. Upon learning of the investigation, the district immediately placed Mr. Wise on administrative leave. Detectives collaborated with the Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.

Mr. Wise was lodged on the above charges in the Washington County Jail and has posted bail. His next court date is January 31, 2014 at 8:30 a.m.
