Bend Man Arrested for Assault with Knife

On Saturday April 2, 2016 at 11:41 p.m., Washington County Deputies serving the City of Cornelius responded to a reported fight on South Beech Street. Deputies investigating the fight learned a knife was used and the suspect had fled the scene. The suspect was located by deputies and arrested.



On April 2, 2016, Washington County deputies responded to a report of a fight. Witnesses reported a domestic dispute occurring in the street. When a friend attempted to intervene, Armando Puac-Damaso, 35, of Bend, pulled a knife and assaulted Miguel Gonzales-Fajado, 36, also of Bend. Both men were in attending a party in Cornelius with their families at a friend's house.

Mr. Puac-Damaso fled the scene and was located driving east on

Highway 26. He was taken into custody without incident. Mr. Gonzales-Fajado injuries were not life threatening and he declined medical transportation to the hospital.

Mr. Puac-Damaso was lodged in the Washington County Jail. He is charged with Attempted Assault I, Assault II, Unlawful Use of a Weapon, Assault IV and Menacing.
