Carlton Woman Dies After Motorcycle Crash

April 18, 2015 - Earlier today a woman was critically injured, and later died at the hospital, after a car pulled in front of her motorcycle. No charges are expected in this case.

On Saturday, April 18, 2015, at about 11:53 a.m., Washington County Sheriff's deputies responded to a crash involving a three-wheeled motorcycle and a car at the intersection of Hwy. 47 and SW Old Hwy 47.

Deputies determined that Charlene Marvin, 64, of Carlton was driving her 2006 Harley Davidson three-wheeled motorcycle south on Hwy 47. A 51-year-old Gaston woman,

driving a 2014 Mazda 3, pulled onto the highway striking Ms. Marvin's motorcycle.



Ms. Marvin was Lifeflighted from the scene and later died of her injuries at an area hospital. Her family was notified of her death.

The Washington County Crash Analysis Reconstruction Team (CART) investigated the crash do not have any reason to believe any criminal factors exist at this time. The driver of the Mazda was not charged.
