## Deputies Arrest Aloha Man in Auto Repair Burglary

June 13, 2020

On Wednesday, June 10, 2020, at 7:21 p.m, a Washington County Sheriff's Office deputy was on patrol in the community of Aloha when she observed a male speeding in a white Ford F-150 in the area of SW Blanton Street and SW 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue. When the deputy attempted to stop the truck, the driver sped away and ran a red light. Deputies did not pursue for safety reasons. During the investigation, it was determined that the truck had been stolen earlier in the week during a burglary of an auto repair shop. A deputy recognized the driver of the stolen truck to be 26-year-old Ahmed Sadiq, of Aloha.

On June 11, 2020, a deputy was on patrol in the same area when she noticed the same white Ford F-150 parked in an apartment complex parking lot with Mr. Sadiq inside. Deputies took Mr. Sadiq into custody. They also arrested a passenger in the truck, 28-year-old Ethan Alexander, of Aloha. Inside of the stolen truck, deputies found keys to another car stolen during the auto shop burglary. They found that stolen car in the same parking lot.



Mr. Sadiq was booked into the Washington County Jail on the following charges:

- Aggravated theft in the first degree
- Burglary in the second degree
- Unauthorized use of a motor vehicle (4 counts)
- Attempting to elude police officer- felony
- Reckless driving
- Theft in the third degree
- Parole violation

Mr. Alexander was issued a criminal citation for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle.
