Deputies Arrest Three Following Drug Related Armed Robbery

December 9, 2014—Sheriff's Deputies responded to a possible robbery with a firearm where three men were identified as suspects. Deputies quickly located and arrested all three.

On December 8, 2014, at 2:02 p.m., Washington County Sheriff's Deputies were called to a reported confrontation involving three men yelling at several other people in the 5300 block of SW 169th Place in the community of Aloha. It was reported that one of the three men had a handgun and they took items from the victims. Sheriff's Deputies arrived and found the three men fled in a black Toyota Prius in an unknown direction.

All local law enforcement were notified of the incident and assisted in the deputies' search for the vehicle and the three occupants. Within minutes, a Beaverton Police Officer located the Prius driving on SW Tualatin Valley (TV) Highway and SW Murray Boulevard. After Sheriff's Deputies arrived, the vehicle was stopped at SW TV Highway and SW Hocken Avenue. The high risk traffic stop only interrupted the flow of traffic on SW TV Highway for about six minutes while all three men were removed safely from the vehicle and detained. The hand gun was unaccounted for and believed to have been hidden.

Sheriff's Deputies detained Joshua Dwayne Johnson, 25, Brendan Cole Schumacher, 21 and Jeremy Matthew Shinder, 18, all from Beaverton. Sheriff's Deputies interviewed the victims and witnesses and believe this was a drug related incident.

It was reported the three men used a ruse to lure the two victims to a secluded area and rob them. There was reported to be bad feelings over one of the victims previously stealing marijuana growing equipment from the men. The three men reportedly threatened the victims several times as they

sped through the streets of Aloha attempting to corner their car. The victims eventually drove down a dead-end street and were cornered. The three men reportedly found them and again threatened them and a bystander with a gun and physical violence.

The bystander called the Sheriff's Office to report the incident. Knowing deputies were called, the men fled in their vehicle.

Joshua Johnson, Brendan Schumacher and Jeremy Shinder were all lodged in the Washington County Jail. They were all charged with two counts of First Degree Robbery. They are held on \$500,000 bail each. There is the possibility of additional charges as the investigation continues.
