Deputies Search for Drive-by Shooting Suspect

February 15, 2016—Washington County Sheriff's Deputies are searching for the person that fired a gun into a house early this morning. Although there were several people in the house at the time of the shooting, no injuries were reported.

On February 15, 2016 at 6:00 a.m., Sheriff's Deputies were called to a residence in the 1800 block of SW 194th Avenue in the community of Aloha, concerning a drive-by shooting. The resident called to report her house had been shot.

Upon arrival, deputies found the front of the house with damage consistent with being shot at least five times with a handgun. They found bullet holes in the front exterior walls and through the front windows. Sheriff's Deputies searched for the suspect but were unable to locate the responsible person. The Washington County Forensics



Science Unit assisted with processing evidence and photographing the scene.

Sheriff's Deputies were told by two different neighbors that they heard several gunshots at about 6:00 a.m., and then called 911. There are no known suspects and it appears the house was not randomly chosen as it was the only house to receive damage. There is information to lead Sheriff's Deputies to believe the gunshots were fired from a vehicle as it drove by.
