Deputies Search for Missing Endangered Juvenile



November 30, 2013—Sheriff's Detectives are seeking the public's help in locating a missing 15 year-old boy. Deputies believe he may be in danger due to his functionality level and being outdoors overnight.

On November 30, 2013, at about 3:30 p.m., Sheriff's Deputies were called to the 19900 block of SW Jaylee Street in Aloha, concerning 15 year-old Alex Chisholm. Deputies were told that Alex lives at a group home in Cornelius. He was visiting the SW Jaylee Street residence when he walked away at about 2:00 p.m. today.

The family reported that Alex functions at a 10 year-old level and has other medical issues. He has limited capacity to ride public transportation. It was reported that Alex may run if contacted. Alex has been entered into the Law Enforcement Data System, which will assist any peace officer that comes into contact with him.

Washington County Sheriff's Search and Rescue, Cornelius Police Department, and TriMet are assisting in the search for Alex. He is a white male, 5'9", 150 pounds with brown hair (photo attached). He was last seen wearing blue jeans, a dark blue colored sweatshirt, and black shoes.

It is believed he may be attempting to make his way back to Cornelius, but he is unfamiliar with the way and may be vulnerable to strangers.
