Sheriff's Detectives Search for Bank Robbery Suspect

October 23, 2015—Washington County Sheriff's Detectives are searching for a woman after she robbed a US Bank.

On October 19, 2015, at 2:19 p.m., Sheriff's Deputies were called to the US Bank at 19091 SW Tualatin Valley Highway in the community of Aloha, concerning a reported robbery. Upon arrival, deputies learned that a woman robbed the bank and fled the area.

Sheriff's Deputies were told the woman entered the bank alone and went to a teller window. The teller told Sheriff's Deputies that the woman had her sleeves pulled over her hands as she displayed a note demanding cash. The teller gave the woman a small amount of cash and she fled the bank. The teller was not injured.

Sheriff's Deputies searched the area with no success. Investigators believe the suspect used a vehicle to flee the area. Investigators are inspecting surveillance video and other evidence. There are two still photos of the suspect from the bank surveillance video

attached to this release.

Unit were contacted and are
continuing the investigation
with assistance from the FBI.

The suspect was described as a white female in her 20's with a thin build. She was wearing dark clothing and hat with dark framed glasses.
