February Enhanced DUII Patrols

February 9, 2017 - The Washington County Sheriff's Office, in partnership with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), will conduct high-visibility enforcement patrols beginning February 10th through February 28th looking for impaired drivers.

Many of these DUII patrols are made up of deputies working grant-funded overtime provided by ODOT and NHTSA. The Washington County Sheriff's Office encourages people not to drink or use drugs and drive. Impaired drivers are involved in a significant number of injury and fatal traffic crashes each year.

If you're going to consume alcoholic beverages or recreational marijuana make sure to have a designated sober driver or arrange for an alternate form of transportation.



The Sheriff's Office reminds you to drive sober or get pulled over.
