Hillsboro Man Dies in Crash

June 24, 2015—Sheriff's Deputies responded to a crash where a vehicle left the roadway and crashed. The vehicle was only occupied by the driver who did not survive his injuries.

On June 24, 2015, at 11:45 a.m., Washington County Sheriff's Deputies were called to NW Jackson School Road, north of NW Evergreen Road outside of Hillsboro concerning a single vehicle crash.



Several deputies arrived and discovered a 1986 Ford Ranger pickup on its side at the edge of NW Jackson School Road. Deputies determined that the Ford had been southbound on NW Jackson School Road when it crashed. The Ford was reportedly traveling at about 60mph when it made an abrupt right turn into a large oak tree.

Sheriff's Deputies found that Patrick Michael Conley, 52, from Hillsboro, was the driver. He was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Jackson School Road was closed for about two

hours to gather evidence and document the scene. Investigators have not determined if there are other factors that contributed to this crash. This case is still under investigation.
