Information Sought on Hit-and-Run Driver who Struck Elderly Man

On Saturday, February 1, 2020, at 3:15 p.m., Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a hit-and-run crash in the 6900 block of NW Kansas City Road, north of the city of Forest Grove.

Deputies learned that an 81-year-old man was getting the mail from his mailbox when a car left the road and struck him. The impact spun the man around and threw him into a ditch. He suffered a knee injury as a result of being hit.
