## Keizer Man Dies in Crash

September 30, 2016—Sheriff's Deputies responded to a crash where a vehicle crossed the center line and collided head on with another. One of the drivers did not survive his injuries.

On September 30, 2016 at 8:38 a.m., Washington County Sheriff's Deputies were called to the area SW Scholls Ferry Road near SW Rainbow Lane, concerning a head-on vehicle crash.

Sheriff's Deputies determined that Paul Douglas Ingraham II, 32, of Keizer was driving a 2002 Mazda Protégé and traveled across the center line of the roadway colliding head-on into a 2016 Toyota Highlander driven by Caryn Jean Jennings, 54, of Poulsbo, Washington.

Mr. Ingraham was pronounced deceased at the scene and Ms. Jennings was transported to the hospital for minor injuries.

The Washington County Crash Analysis Reconstruction Team responded to gather evidence and document the scene.

The road was closed for about three hours. Investigators believe excessive speed by Mr. Jennings contributed to this crash. Investigators have not determined if there were any other factors that contributed to this crash.
