Sheriff's Deputies Search for "Lucky Dog Deli" Robbery Suspect

November 6, 2016—Washington County Sheriff's Deputies are searching for a man after he robbed a local business.

On November 5, 2016 at 6:45 p.m., Sheriff's Deputies were called to the Lucky Dog Deli at 4714 SW Scholls Ferry Road in the community of Raleigh Hills, concerning a robbery. Upon arrival, Sheriff's Deputies were told there was a man that robbed the 26 year-old male clerk at gunpoint.

Sheriff's Deputies were told the robbery suspect came into the business and walked quickly towards the clerk who was behind the counter. The clerk told Sheriff's Deputies the man had a handgun and demanded the cash in the register. The employee gave the man a small amount of cash and the man fled on foot. The employee was not harmed.

Sheriff's Deputies searched the area with the assistance of a Sheriff's Office K9 with no success in locating the suspect. There is the possibility a vehicle was used to flee the area. Investigators are reviewing surveillance video and other evidence.

The man was described as a Latino male, in his late 20s with a medium build. He was reported to have a purple bandana over his face. He was reportedly wearing a black hoody sweatshirt and black sweatpants.
