## Learning Center Owners Arrested for Conduct with Teenage Girl

September 5, 2018

On August 13, 2018, a concerned citizen contacted the Washington County Sheriff's Office after learning that an adult male had engaged in a sexual relationship with a teenage girl. Detectives from the Violent Crimes Unit were assigned to investigate.

During the investigation, detectives confirmed that the information reported was accurate. They also learned that the suspect's younger brother had provided alcohol to the underage female.

On August 16, 2018, detectives arrested Ryan Hsu, 31, of Bethany, for sexual abuse in the second degree. He posted \$1,000 bail and was released from the jail.

He was arrested again on August 30, 2018 for violating the terms of his release agreement. It was learned that he attended a community event where minors were

present. He posted \$2,500 bail and was again released from jail.

On August 18, 2018, deputies arrested Alan H. Hsu, 29, of Bethany, for furnishing alcohol to a minor. He was released on his own recognizance.

The Hsus own and operate the Best in Class Education Center in Bethany. Through their work, they have had extensive contact over the years with children and teenagers. It is through their work that they met the victim in this investigation.

On September 4, 2018, a Washington County grand jury indicted Ryan Hsu on seven counts of sexual abuse in the second degree.
