
Pedestrian Suffers Life-Threatening Injuries Following Traffic Crash on Pacific Highway


July 11, 2018 – A pedestrian suffered critical, life-threatening injuries when she was struck by a vehicle on Pacific Highway south of King City. Speed or impairment are not believed to be factors in this crash.

On Tuesday, July 10, 2018, at 10:10 p.m., Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a traffic crash involving a vehicle and pedestrian in the 17000 block of Pacific Highway outside of King City.

Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue provided medical aid and transported the injured 25-year-old female pedestrian to a local hospital with critical, life-threatening injuries.

Based on preliminary information gathered, investigators believe the pedestrian was crossing Pacific Highway when she was struck by a
