Located at 600 SW Walnut Street in Hillsboro, this 20 million dollar facility has been in the works for several years. The 116,029 square foot building was designed to be an all-inclusive training center for law enforcement. It features offices, classrooms, two indoor shooting ranges, an outdoor emergency vehicle training course, defensive tactics mat rooms, armory, and the region's largest scenario village and mock jail.

This new training center brings all types of training into one centralized location. We believe this valuable resource will improve public safety training for not only our agency , but for our partner agencies as well, resulting in improved public safety for everyone.
