Shooting Suspects in Custody after Extensive Search

May 29, 2016—Two men are in custody in connection with a shooting in an Aloha shopping center parking lot.

On May 28, 2016 at 9:48 p.m. Washington County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to a shooting in the Aloha Market Centre parking lot, located at 20571 SW Tualatin Valley Highway in the community of Aloha. Upon arrival, Sheriff's Deputies found a male with what appeared to be a gunshot wound.

A Sheriff's Deputy was near the area at the time of the shooting and was able to broadcast a description and license plate of the suspect's vehicle as it fled westbound on SW Tualatin Valley Highway. While the Sheriff's Deputy rendered aid to the victim, dispatchers notified the Hillsboro Police Department of the shooting and the vehicle's description.



Within five minutes, an officer with the Hillsboro Police Department spotted the vehicle at SW Cornelius Pass Road and SE Lois Street and attempted to stop it. The driver did not stop and sped eastbound on SE Lois Street. The vehicle crashed into a fence at SE Imlay Avenue and SE Lois Street. Two men ran from the vehicle and one was captured after a short foot chase. The second male continued to run westbound through a residential area. After an extensive search with K9s from Hillsboro Police and the Sheriff's Office, the second suspect was located at 11:53 p.m., over two hours after the shooting.

Washington County Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Unit Detectives, the

Washington County Interagency Gang Enforcement Team and the Washington County Forensic Science Unit responded to assist with the investigation and process the scene.

There is no additional information available, including the names of the individuals involved, at this early stage of the investigation. Additional information should be available later on May 29, 2016.
