Truck Catches Fire When DUI Driver Crashes

June 14, 2015 — A man was arrested for DUII after he rolled his vehicle in rural Washington County. Sheriff's Deputies determined the use of alcohol was a contributing factor to the crash.

June 13, 2015, at 11:16 p.m., Sheriff's Deputies were called to a crash on SW Tongue Lane in rural Washington County on a report of a truck on fire. Deputies located a 2004



Toyota Tacoma fully engulfed in flames. Deputies learned that the driver, Daniel Donovan, 32, of Portland failed to negotiate a sharp turn in the road. As a result, he drove off the road and rolled his truck which then caught fire. He was able to exit the truck with non-life threatening injuries.

During the investigation, deputies determined that Mr. Donovan was driving under the influence (DUII) of alcohol. He was taken by ambulance to the hospital to be treated for his injuries. Deputies criminally cited Mr. Donovan for DUII to appear in court at a later date.
